Scripture: Genesis 6:12-22

The History:

- A) _____ of God are based on it
Isaiah 54:9 - "For this is as the waters of Noah unto me: for as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with thee, nor rebuke thee."
- B) Noah is included as a _____ figure in the New Testament
- An ancestor of Christ: **Luke 3:36**
- A hero of the Faith: **Hebrews 11:7**
- An example & warning for the future:
1 Peter 3:20 – "Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water."
2 Peter 2:5 – "And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly"
- C) _____ believed in Noah and taught the flood as real _____
Matthew 24:37-39 - "But as the days of Noe [Noah] were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be."

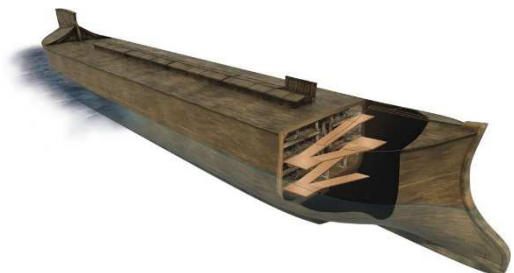
Order (*Grazing Mammals*)
