1) Why _____ in the Whale?

A) _____ to sin – “I prefer my way”

Proverbs 1:30-32 – “They would none of my counsel: they despised all my reproof. Therefore shall they eat of the fruit of their own way, and be filled with their own devices. For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.”

B) _____ – “I don’t need God’s help”

Psalm 10:4 – “The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek after God: God is not in all his thoughts.”

Proverbs 16:18 – “Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.”

C) _____ - “I deserve this”

Psalm 44:15 – “My confusion is continually before me, and the shame of my face hath covered me”

Jeremiah 3:25 – “We lie down in our shame, and our confusion covereth us: for we have sinned against the LORD our God, we and our fathers, from our youth even unto this day, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD our God.”

A) Look _____

Romans 15:4 – “For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.”

Hebrews 12:2 – “Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.”

B) _____ the Lord

Hebrews 4:15-16 – “For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”

Psalm 86:5 – “For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee.”

C) Forsake the _____ (that you’ve told yourself)

Remember the truth about God & His mercy

Proverbs 3:3 – “Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart” (See also: **Psalm 136**)

Remember that Devil’s way is the hard way

Psalm 32:10 – “Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.”

Remember you can always go back

Isaiah 55:7 – “Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.”

D) Give _____

Psalms 59:16 – “But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defense and refuge in the day of my trouble.”

E) _____ (*change your thinking!*)

Revelation 3:18-19 – “I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.”

F) _____ in God alone

Psalm 13:5 – “But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.”

Psalm 62:2 – “He only is my rock and my salvation; he is my defence; I shall not be greatly moved.”
